Pupil Asset Parent Portal

- All parents/carers should have received a link to access the Pupil Asset Parent Portal. This will allow you to update your contact details, and a notification of any changes will be sent to the school.

- Reception and Year 1 parents will be able to book a Phonics event (30 spaces) taking place on Wednesday 16th November at 9am.

Flu Immunisation Spray - Reception to Year 6

- If you gave consent for your child to receive the flu immunisation spray in school and they were present on Tuesday 1st November, your child should have received the vaccine.
- The Vaccination Team will be revisiting Ashleigh (date to be advised) to immunise any children absent on 1st November.
- As soon as we know the new date we will let parents/carers know. The Vaccination Team did ask that all parents follow the link to confirm whether or not you consent for your child to be vaccinated, or they will make contact direct.

Year 1 & 2 Phonics

This week in phonics we have been recapping sounds and practising speedy reading. Children will be starting new groups on Monday so they will receive their new books by the end of next week. They will still have the books from before half term, plus their library book. Please keep practising the words and sounds in the phonics books to help your child increase their fluency which will really support them to make progress in Read Write Inc. Phonics.

NEW - Weekly Talking Homework

- At the beginning of this year, we started to send home Knowledge Organisers so that parents could see in detail the different areas of the curriculum their children will be covering. Since then, we have enjoyed seeing the confidence of our children grow in so many areas and want to do everything we can to get them talking about their learning even more!
- To help with this we want to share our weekly 'Talk Homework' questions.
- This is not a piece of homework your children can do alone! Homework of this kind involves discussion only. These questions have been designed by your child's class teacher to get them thinking about something which they have recently covered or something that will be coming next.

We think it is important because it will give your child a chance to:

- *Help them think through and discuss initial ideas in order to develop the thought process;*
- *Develop their opinions on certain topics;*
- *Share your own opinion and how it is fine to have different views or opinions;*
- *Develop their vocabulary through the use of "ambitious" vocabulary.*

Some hints for parents taking part in a talking homework conversation:

- *Encourage as many family members as possible to be involved in the Talk Homework;*
- *Make it an enjoyable activity;*
- *Switch off the television to try to ensure that this is dedicated talking and listening time;*
- *Use the 'because' word to explain why they might have a different idea;*
- *Encourage thinking about exciting words to use to make their writing more interesting;*
- *Begin a conversation by modelling... "I think that... because"*

Year 1	DT What is the best material to use to make a puppet?
Year 2	History Why do we remember Guy Fawkes? What was he trying to achieve? What date was he arrested?

Year 4	Computing What three components would you need in an electrical circuit to light a bulb?
Year 5	English What are adverts? How can you make an advert persuasive?
Year 6	History How many Allied and Axis countries can you name from World War 2? What is an Axis controlled country?
