Dentist Visit - Reception to Year 6 - Tuesday 17th June

This week we have emailed details of the planned dentist visit offering check-ups to children in school on Tuesday 17th June.

What is Dental Screening?

Dental screening is an examination of children's teeth inside the school setting. Its purpose is to identify oral health concerns at an early stage and prompt parents and carers to seek treatment where required.

What happens at a school screening session?

The screening is completed by a dentist from John G Plummer & Associates Dental Surgeons. Sterile dental mirrors are used to move the cheek or tongue aside to check all the tooth surfaces for decay. Each screening takes approximately 3 minutes. Dental report forms are sent home with children to provide parents with information regarding their child's oral health.

What happens if my child has a dental problem?

If an urgent dental condition is detected in your child's mouth, you will also receive a follow up appointment for treatment. You will be contacted by telephone a few days after the screening date.

Children will be bringing home the Consent Form that **must be signed and returned to school if you wish your child to be seen by the dentist.**

If your child already has a dentist and you do not wish them to be seen in school you do not need to complete and return the form.
