- Deliveries will begin again week commencing 12<sup>th</sup> January.

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## Nursery Funding Information

The funding period for Spring starts from 6th January to 27th March 2026.

- **You will only receive a funding form to check and sign if your child was born between 1st September and 31st December**, as the funding cycle for these children restarts and Spring 2026 will be your 1st Claim Period. These will be handed out this week at drop off and pick up times.
- **For children born between 1st January and 31st March**, you do not need to complete a new funding form until the Summer Term, as Spring 2026 is your 3rd Claim period, so the form you completed in September 2025 is still valid. However, if any of your circumstances have changed, or you have made changes to your child's contracted hours then please let me know.
- **For children born between 1st April and 31st August**, you will not need to complete another funding form unless any of your circumstances have changed, or if/when you make any changes to your child's contracted hours. Spring 2026 is your 2nd Claim period and the form you completed in September will be valid for the full school year.
