Government Change to School Attendance Legislation from September 2024

You may be aware from recent press coverage that the government is introducing new school attendance legislation from September 2024, to create a single national approach.

Amongst other changes, fixed penalty notices for unauthorised absence are increasing the fine amounts to:

- £160 if paid within 28 days (reduced to £80 when paid within 21 days);
- A flat rate of £160 for a second penalty notice within a three-year period;
- Only 2 penalty notices within a three-year period, any additional occurrences will mean an alternative route (e.g. prosecution) will be considered instead;
- Schools will be required to report pupils who have 15 days of absence due to illness (consecutive or cumulative).

We are awaiting further guidance from Norfolk County Council and will share details once available.
