Wymondham's nearest junior parkrun events are currently at Watton Sports Centre and in Norwich at Eaton Park and Lea Bridges Park. But

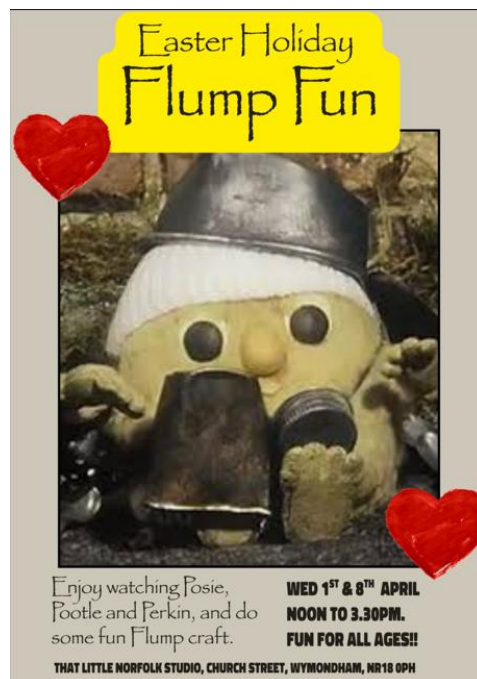
soon young people and their families will be able to come along to Wymondham High Academy and walk, jog, run or volunteer at a brand new junior parkrun.
