Content

- Children will learn what Geography means and why we learn about it
- Children will learn that they belong to a community e.g. school similarities and differences
- Children will learn about maps and how to draw information from them similarities and differences about their walk to school
- Children will learn how to describe what they can see, hear and feel whilst outside
- Children will learn that what they see, feel and hear is about their environment

This will include a local area walk.

Past and Present: Talk about the lives of the people around them. Know some similarities and differences between things in the past and now, drawing on their experiences.
