For the first couple of weeks of Autumn 2, we will be learning all about fireworks and festivals, celebrations and special days.

The children will have project sessions which we will use to discuss events children celebrate, special days in their lives, as well as learning about specific celebrations or special days such as Diwali, Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day. In Maths, the children will explore numbers 1 to 10; counting forwards and backwards, counting objects and counting using 5 and 10 frames. We will also learn how to find more or less than a given number and compare quantities. We will soon be starting learning phonics in groups rather than as a whole class and we will communicate this information with you on Seesaw soon. The children will continue to learn single letter sounds. They will also learn to orally blend and learn how to use this skill to blend sounds to read. The children will also start to write short, simple words.
