

<p><b>English</b></p> <p>This term in English we are still focussing on becoming confident writers using:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Finger spaces</li> <li>• Full stops</li> <li>• Capital letters</li> </ul> <p>We will carry on creating different pieces of 'Showcase Writing', where we will use our Story Time texts as inspiration to create a variety of different texts. This half term our texts will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- After the fall</li> <li>- Frockodile</li> <li>- On The Way Home</li> <li>- London's Burning</li> </ul>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>In maths, we will be working on division by grouping and sharing equally. We will also begin working on fractions by making halves and quarters by sharing and grouping.</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>In science we will be revisiting weather and seasonal changes, by taking part in some practical experiments around the weather.</p> <p><b>RE</b></p> <p>The children will learn that celebrations are a key part of practising religious belief and worship within religions. They will learn about the Hindu and Christian festivals of Holi and Easter.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p><b>How can we save memories on a computer/tablet?</b></p> <p>In computing, the children will be learning how to take photographs and save them digitally (via PicCollage). They will learn how to open the correct apps, take photos and add text to them.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Year 1</b> <b>Spring 2 - Learning Map</b></p> 	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>In music, we look at different style in each unit. This half term we will be looking at two songs: Rhythm In The Way We Walk (Reggae style) and Banana Rap (Hip Hop style). The children will 'Listen &amp; Appraise' other styles of music and continue to embed the interrelated dimensions of music through games and singing.</p>
<p><b>DT</b></p> <p><b><u>Can you make a picture move?</u></b></p> <p>The children will learn that objects can move in different ways, depending on the mechanism used. The children will make a card using a slide or lever to make a picture move.</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>This half term we will be focussing on 'perseverance' and 'confidence.' We will be learning about making mistakes, and what we should do if we make a mistake. We will also be thinking about how it is good to be you and ok to like and dislike different things.</p>	<p><b>PE</b></p> <p><b>Sending and receiving</b></p> <p>In this unit, the children will develop their sending and receiving skills including throwing and catching, rolling, kicking, tracking and stopping a ball. Pupils will be given opportunities to work with a range of different balls.</p> <p><b>Net and wall</b></p> <p>The children will learn different sports such as tennis, badminton and volleyball. In this unit, the children will develop their understanding of attacking and defending</p>

		<p>principles in net games, such as using a ready position to defend their court and placement of a ball into space. They use and develop skills such as throwing, catching, tracking and hitting a ball.</p>
