<b>Manger</b> – The place Jesus was laid.	<b>Inn</b> – A building where people can go and stay.
<b>Christian</b> – A person that follows the Christian religion.	<b>Believe</b> – To feel that something is true.
<b>Worship</b> – Giving thanks to God.	<b>Pray</b> – Used as a way to speak to God.
<b>Bethlehem</b> – The place Jesus was born.	<b>Mary</b> – Jesus' mother.
<b>Joseph</b> – Jesus' father.	<b>Donkey</b> – The animal that carried Mary to Jerusalem.
<b>Celebration</b> – To give thanks and feel joy.
