

Year I Shape Big question: Can I do and Pattern | art without painting?

Key Concept: You can use a range of media beyond drawing and painting to recreate shapes and pattern we see around us.

Key skills

In this unit, children will learn and critique different artists who use shape and pattern in their artworks. They will create their own works of art inspired by those artists.

Children will explore collage and printing when making their artworks.

Children will work together and independently to discover that not all artist use pencils and paint to create their masterpieces!

Key Vocabulary:	Definition:
Pattern	A repetitive decorative design
Collage	A piece of art made by sticking various materials down.
Print	A process of transferring a text or design onto fabric or paper
Texture	The surface of an object-rough, smooth, slimy
Op Art	Meaning optical art. This is art that creates an optical illusion.
