Key Vocabulary

aerial photograph	is the taking of photographs from an aircraft or other airborne platforms
fieldwork	practical work conducted by a researcher in the natural environment
geography	It is about Earth's land, water, air, and living things—particularly people
human feature	Human features are things like houses, roads and bridges. They have been built by people.
Norwich	Norwich is a city in the county of Norfolk, England
physical feature	Physical features like seas, mountains and rivers are natural.
River Tiffey	A river that runs through Wymondham
vegetation	Vegetation is the groupings of plant species and the ground cover they provide
Wymondham	is a market town in the South Norfolk district of Norfolk, England
