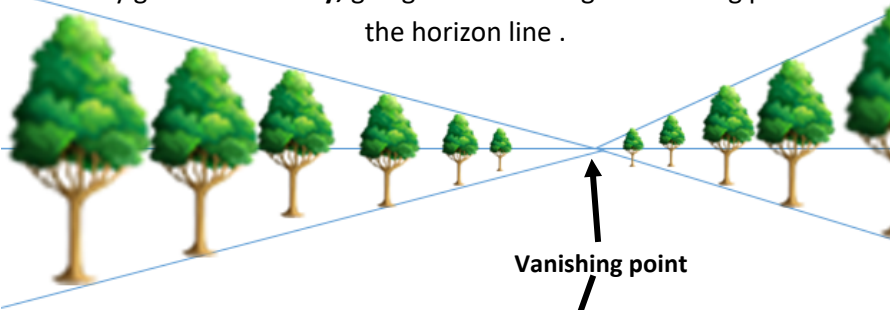




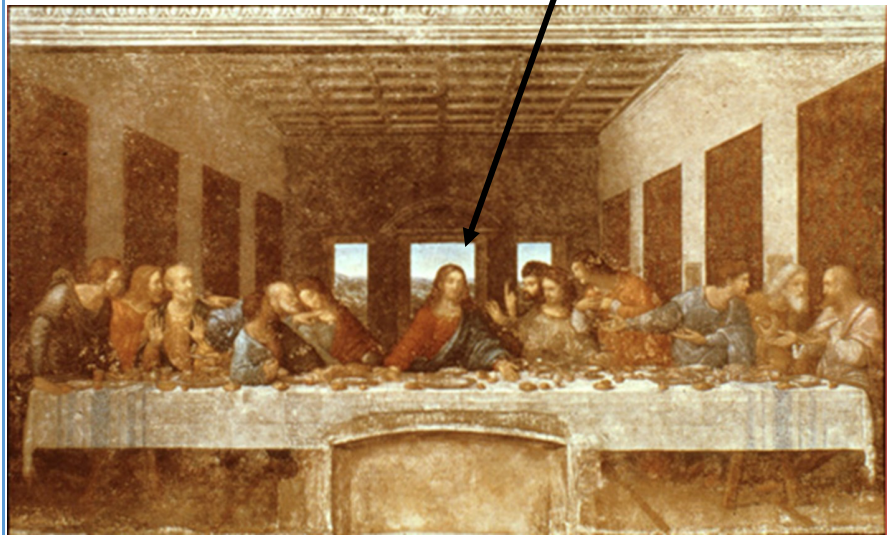
Key knowledge

One point perspective

a drawing method that shows how things appear to get **smaller** as they get **further away**, going towards a single 'vanishing point' on the horizon line .

Key Vocabulary

Definition

Composition	The arrangement of elements within a work of art.
Perspective	The feeling of a flat piece of work being 3D (having depth / thickness).
Landscape	A piece of artwork that shows the outside environment.
Depth	Thickness : The sense of distance between the front and the back of a picture.
Foreground	The part of an artwork that appears closest to the viewer, typically at the bottom of a composition.
Midground	The middle ground occupies the space in between the foreground and the background.
Background	An area of a painting that appears to be furthest from the viewer.
Vanishing point	Where all the perspective lines meet, at one point in the distance.

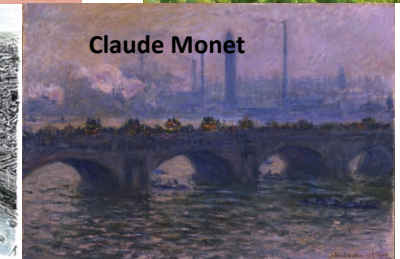
