Information can be found on the internet that comes from humans; some information can be trusted but some cannot.


What should I already know?

Key vocabulary:

Digital	Something that is shown on an electronic device.
Information	Facts and opinions used to inform us.
Website	A page found on the internet used to give information.
Trustworthy	Something that we can trust.
Spell Check	Something that checks spellings and helps correct them.
Search Engine	A website used to search other websites for words on the internet.
Search Ranking	The order in which websites are shown after using a search engine.
E-Book	A digital book rather than a physical one.
Filters	Something that stops someone from seeing things that may harm them on the internet.
Text Box	A section or object on a page that allows a user to enter text.
Present	To show something to someone for them to think about.
